Changes in Undergraduate Courses/Curricula:

B.S. Speech Communications – all options

Require a grade of C or higher in COMM 401.

Rationale: The minimum grade requirement is currently the university minimum of a D-. The other core courses for Speech Communications required a grade of C or higher. Given the importance of demonstrating adequate knowledge of all information and concepts in all four courses (COMM 101, 201, 301 and 401), the department felt that it was important to ensure that students applied equal effort across all four courses.

ESCI 347 – Satellite Meteorology

- Existing 3 credit, electives course for Meteorology majors, G2 general education course for non-majors. Pre-requisites: ESCI 241 and MATH 161 or 163. Recently converted to distance learning format.
- **Update course description** to align the course with the Federal satellite meteorology guidelines from the National Environmental Satellite, Data, and Information Service, Satellite Meteorology and Climatology division mission statement.
- **Remove** G2 general education designation from university catalog
- **Revise pre-requisites:** ESCI 241 and ESCI 340 and PHYS 232
