**WHEREAS: Dr. Keith A. Lauderbach, Department of Industry and Technology, retired on May 25, 2007, after 29 years of teaching and service at Millersville University; and**

**WHEREAS: Dr. Lauderbach served as an effective educator of undergraduate and graduate students in desktop publishing, communication technology, graphic reproduction, digital imaging, architectural and engineering drafting, metals, research and development studies, pedagogy, student teaching, and Macintosh-based educational workshops; and**

**WHEREAS: Dr. Lauderbach served the department as chair of the Budget, Educational Workshops, and Professional Standards Committees; as a member of the Curriculum and Assessment, Facilities Renovation, Graduate, and several other Committees; and as an advisor to the Industrial Arts Society, Epsilon Pi Tau, and Marauder Graphics; and**

**WHEREAS: Dr. Lauderbach served as chair of the university Provost Search Committee as well as a contributing member of the Vice President for Finance and Administration Search Committee, the Vice President for Information Technology Search Committee, the Director of Affirmative Action and Human Relations Search Committee, the Associate Provost Search Committee, the Technology Vision Task Force, and the APSCUF Legislative Assembly; and**

**WHEREAS: Dr. Lauderbach served the community as president of the Susquehanna Litho Club, a member of the Board of Trustees for The Thaddeus Stevens State School of Technology, a member of the Susquehanna Litho Foundation Board of Directors, an advisor to the Pennsylvania Council for College Students in Technology Education, a member of the Manheim Central School District Curriculum Committee, and a team leader of the Appalachia Service Project;**

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That Dr. Keith A. Lauderbach be granted the honorary title of Professor of Industry and Technology Emeritus.**
