### **Faculty Senate action at October 19, 2010, meeting:**

#### **New Graduate Course(s):**

##### **SOWK 611 – Children and Youth At-Risk**

- 3 credits, Pre-requisites: SOWK 521 or SOWK 601; elective course for M.S.W. program.
- Distance Learning Format
- CIP CODE: 44.0701
- Faculty Load: One section of this course will be offered annually during the summer session.

#### **New Undergraduate Course(s):**

##### **SPED 346 – Secondary Students with Disabilities in Inclusive Settings: Educational & Social Implications**

- 3 credits, Pre-requisites: EDFN 211 and 241; required course for all secondary education programs.
- CIP CODE: 13.1001
- Faculty Load: Three or four sections will be offered annually during the fall semester.

**Changes in Undergraduate Courses/Curricula:**

**PHYS 131 – Physics I with Algebra**

- **Revise** Pre-requisites: “competence in algebra and trigonometry is assumed” **TO** MATH 101 or MATH Placement Testing score sufficient for the student to enroll in MATH courses above MATH 110.

**Approved, effective FALL 2011 registration (Early registration scheduled for March 2011 would have this pre-requisite in place.)**

**New Undergraduate Course(s):**

**SOCY 308 – Sociology of African-American & Latino/a Education**

- 3 credits, Pre-requisites: LATS 201 or SOCY 101 or permission of instructor; elective course for Sociology majors and Latino Studies minor
- Cultural Diversity & Community, General Education Designation
- CIP CODE: 13.0202
- Faculty Load: To be scheduled within complement as one of the rotating electives that is offered annually by the Sociology/Anthropology department.

**New Graduate Course(s):**

**ENGL 670 – Film and Media in the Secondary Classroom**

- 3 credits, Pre-requisites: none; elective course for M.Ed. and M.A. English programs.
- CIP CODE: 50.0601
- Faculty Load: One section of this course will be offered annually during the summer session.

**New Undergraduate Course(s) continued:**

**ERCH 225 – Foundations of Reading**

- 3 credits, Pre-requisites: ERCH 110; required course for the B.S.E. in Early Childhood Pre-Kindergarten to Grade 4 (ERCH).
- CIP CODE: 13.1202
- Faculty Load: To be scheduled during the fall and spring semesters within existing complement.

**SOWK 312 – Social Work and Women’s Issues**

- Existing, 3 credit, required course for Social Work majors
