Directions:

Develop a one-page synopsis (single-spaced, 1" margins, 12pt font) that summarizes what one or two engineering majors may appeal to you the most. You may use the major information sheets (Cut Sheets located outside the main office, Rm 202 Osburn Hall) or University websites such as the AEST Department (<http://www.millersville.edu/aest>) for supportive information about the degree program(s).

The synopsis is to be written in first person and should explain why the engineering major or majors identified appeal to you. The depth of this explanation will be the primary driver of your paper's evaluation. You must support your work. Please note that the expectation for this assignment is a full page of written work. Please do not go over 1-page, however. You are to balance depth and brevity.

This assignment is worth 5% of your total semester grade. Have fun with the assignment and use this opportunity to explore a major related to engineering.

Potential Bonus Points: If you interview/speak with a professor who teaches in that technical area or perhaps to a program coordinator for the major please cite something they told you in your write-up and have that professor send me (your AENG 101 instructor) an email to confirm the meeting – this will be worth 20% more points.
