About The Graphic Communications Program

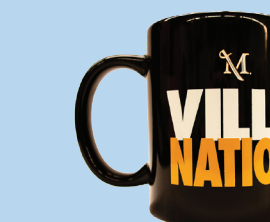

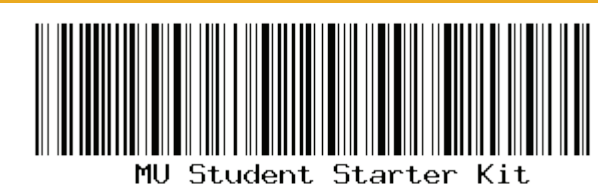
